## Terms and Conditions

1. The following shall apply to all Vendors and their agents (hereinafter referred to as "Exhibitor").
2. **Exhibitor Acceptance.** Swedish Women's Educational Association, Orange County Chapter (SWEA OC), reserves the right to accept or reject any application from a potential Exhibitor. Participation in previous Christmas Fairs does not guarantee or give any preferential rights to participation in this year's Fair. **Space assignment will be made after the entry deadline, October 10, 2024,** and at SWEA OC's sole discretion.
3. **Cancellation.** Written cancellation must be received on or before **Nov 10th, 2024** in order to receive a full refund. No refunds after this date.
4. **Subletting.** The Exhibitor shall not sublet any portion of the assigned space.
5. **Merchandise.** The Exhibitor shall display, exhibit, and sell only such products and/or services as described in the submitted application.
6. **Display Limitation.** Tables, tablecloths, and display equipment furnished by SWEA OC may not be removed or changed in any manner by the Exhibitor. Exhibitor shall only use signs provided by SWEA OC indicating Exhibitor's company, firm, or brand name. Exhibitor shall not hinder, encumber, or encroach on another Exhibitors display or table. Any attachment to the fabric of the market stands is limited to the use of pins, removable double-sided adhesive tape, and the weight of items so affixed shall not damage the fabric.
7. **Electric Installation.** Electrical outlets are provided as per request and upon availability only. Connecting cords and Exhibitor's electrical equipment must be taped, covered, and secured to the floor in order to avoid accidents of any kind.
8. **Fire Proofing.** All materials including those used for display purposes, must be suitably fire-proofed.

9. **Transportation and Set-Up.** The Exhibitor is responsible for transportation and installation of all merchandise and exhibiting equipment as well as removal immediately following the conclusion of the Fair. Set-up time is 8:30 am - 10:00 am on Sunday, November 24, 2024.
10. **Timetable.** Exhibitors must remain present in the assigned space from 10:30 am to 4:00 pm. Breakdown or abandonment of the assigned space prior to 4:00 pm is strictly prohibited.
11. **Security.** The Exhibition area will be patrolled by security provided by Old World. Exhibitors are responsible for securing their own belongings and valuables. SWEA OC assumes no responsibility for lost or stolen items.
12. **Liabilities.** The Exhibitor agrees to hold SWEA OC, Old World, their respective customers, owners, officers, employees, and delegates fully free and harmless from any loss, injury, claim, and/or liability resulting from the operation, installation, or occupancy of space in connection with the Christmas Fair 2024. The Exhibitor further agrees to relinquish the allocated space immediately upon the conclusion of the Fair in the same condition, normal wear and tear excepted, as when received. The Exhibitor assumes full responsibility for any and all damages that may occur as a result of the Exhibitor's use and/or occupancy of the assigned space.
13. **Sales Permits.** A valid State Seller Permit shall be required of the Exhibitor. A permit may be obtained at an office of the State Board of Equalization located within your area. The permit may also be obtained at [www.boe.ca.gov/pdf/boe400spa.pdf](http://www.boe.ca.gov/pdf/boe400spa.pdf).
14. **Licenses and Permits.** The Exhibitor shall be responsible for obtaining and paying for any governmental fees, taxes, licenses, or permits that may be necessary or required in connection with participation in the Christmas Fair.
15. **Breach.** Any breach of these terms and conditions may result in revocation of permission to participate in the Christmas Fair and/or subject the Exhibitor to the payment of damages for any harm or losses caused by the Exhibitor, its licensees, agents, employees, and/or other representatives.
16. **Attorney fees.** In the event of any legal action (including arbitration) to enforce or interpret this Agreement, the non-prevailing Party shall pay the reasonable attorneys' fees and other costs and expenses of the Prevailing Party in such amount as may be determined.
17. **Agreement.** The Exhibitor agrees to these terms and conditions by entering into a contractual agreement with SWEA OC.
